Part 1 Preliminary

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the Road Transport Legislation Amendment Regulation 2017 (No 2).

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the commencement of the *Road Transport Reform (Light Rail) Legislation Amendment Act 2017*, section 3.

3 Legislation amended

This regulation amends the Road Transport (Offences) Regulation 2005 and the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000.

8 Section 38M

substitute

Personal mobility device use alongside more than 1 other person using personal mobility device

(1) A person must not use a personal mobility device on a road or crossing alongside 2 or more other people using personal mobility devices.

Maximum penalty: 20 penalty units.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply if the person is overtaking the other people.

Note The defendant has an evidential burden in relation to the matters mentioned in subsection (2) (see Criminal Code, s 58).

(3) In this section:

crossing—see section 38L (2).

line of traffic—see the Australian Road Rules, dictionary.

marked lane—see the Australian Road Rules, dictionary.

road does not include a road-related area, but includes a bicycle path, footpath, shared path and a shoulder of a road.
