1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Crimes (Surveillance Devices)* Regulation 2017.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).
