AN ORDINANCE

**To amend the Dentists Registration Ordinances 1931,
as amended by the Dentists Registration Ordinance
1932.**

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910-1931, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Dentists Registration Ordinance (No. 2) 1932*. Short title and citation.

(2.) Section one of the *Dentists Registration Ordinance 1932* is amended by omitting sub-section (3.).

(3.) The *Dentists Registration Ordinance 1931*, as amended by the *Dentists Registration Ordinance 1932*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the *Principal Ordinance*.

(4.) The *Principal Ordinance*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Dentists Registration Ordinance 1931-1932*.

2. Section thirty-six of the *Principal Ordinance* is amended by omitting the words “in the ordinary course of his medical or surgical practice where the services of a dentist are not reasonably available”. Medical practitioners may perform dental operations.
