AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Pharmacy Ordinance 1931.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Pharmacy* short title and *Ordinance* 1933.
- (2.) The *Pharmacy Ordinance* 1931 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Pharmacy Ordinance* 1931-1933.
- 2. Section ten of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—
- "10. The Governor-General may, if he is satisfied that any Removal from member has been guilty of misbehaviour or incapacity, remove that member. member from office."
- 3. Section twenty-four of the Principal Ordinance is amended Persons who by omitting the figures "1928" and inserting in their stead the registration. figures and words "1915 or the Medical Act 1928".
- **4.** Section thirty-one of the Principal Ordinance is amended by correction of pmitting from sub-section (1.) the word "Registrar" and inserting in its stead the word "Register".
 - **5**. Section thirty-two of the Principal Ordinance is amended by grounds for adding at the end of sub-section (4.) the words "whose decision cancellation of registration." shall be final and conclusive and without appeal".
 - 6. Section forty-two of the Principal Ordinance is amended—Conduct of (a) by inserting in paragraph (a), after the word pharmacist of pharmacist, the words ", as an assistant or agent of a registered pharmacist"; and

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following para-

graphs:-

": (a) allow his name to be used in connexion with the practice of pharmacy at any premises at which there is not a registered pharmacist in daily attendance: or

(h) aid or assist any person other than a registered pharmacist to practise pharmacy except in accordance with the provisions

of this Ordinance.".

Inquiries into

7. Section forty-nine of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words "and may be enforced in the same manner as the order of a Court of summary jurisdiction" and inserting in their stead the words "The amount specified in any such order shall be a debt due to the Crown and may be sued for and recovered by action instituted by any officer authorized in writing by the Director-General in any Court of Petty Sessions as a civil debt recoverable summarily.".

Regulations.

- 8. Section fifty-four of the Principal Ordinance is amended—
 - (a) by inserting in paragraph (f), after the word "be". the word "manufactured.":
 - (b) by omitting from paragraph (q) the word "and" (last occurring); and
 - (c) by inserting after paragraph (g) the following paragraph:-
 - "(ga) the qualifications of apprentices and the conditions under which apprentices may be employed; and ".
