To amend the *Stock Ordinance 1934-1948*.

STOCK ORDINANCE 1957.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Stock Ordinance 1957*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Stock Ordinance 1934-1948*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Stock Ordinance 1934-1957*.

2. Section seven of the *Stock Ordinance 1934-1948* is Rates. amended—

- (a) by omitting the word “fourpence” and inserting in its stead the words “One shilling”; and
- (b) by omitting the words “two-thirds of a penny” and inserting in their stead the words “One penny half-penny”.
