## STOCK ORDINANCE 1957.

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Stock Ordinance short title and citation.
- (2.) The Stock Ordinance 1934-1948,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Stock Ordinance 1934-1957.
- 2. Section seven of the Stock Ordinance 1934-1948 is Rates. amended—
  - (a) by cmitting the word "fourpence" and inserting in its stead the words "One shilling"; and
  - (b) by comitting the words "two-thirds of a penny" and inserting in their stead the words "One penny half-penny".
