To amend the *Optometrists Ordinance 1956-1957*.

OPTOMETRISTS ORDINANCE 1958.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Optometrists Ordinance 1958*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Optometrists Ordinance 1956-1957*[†] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Optometrists Ordinance 1956-1958*.

2. Section sixteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended—
(a) by omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-section (1.) the word “or”, last occurring; and
(b) by adding at the end of sub-section (1.) the following word and paragraph:—

“or (d) he had, during the whole of the period of five years ending on the day immediately preceding the date of commencement of this Ordinance, been practising optometry in the Territory.”

3. Section twenty-nine of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words "one month" and inserting in their stead the words "twelve months".
