OPTOMETRISTS ORDINANCE 1958.

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Optometrists Short title and citation.
- (2.) The *Optometrists Ordinance* 1956-1957† is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Optometrists Ordinance* 1956-1958.
 - **2.** Section sixteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended— $\frac{Persons}{entitled to}$ to omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-section registration.
 - (1.) the word "or", last occurring; and(b) by adding at the end of sub-section (1.) the follow-
 - (b) by adding at the end of sub-section (1.) the following word and paragraph:—
 - "or (d) he had, during the whole of the period of five years ending on the day immediately preceding the date of commencement of this Ordinance, been practising optometry in the Territory.".
