STOCK DISEASES ORDINANCE 1958.

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Stock Diseases Short title and Crdinance 1958.*
- (2.) The Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1939,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1958.
- 2. Section twelve of the Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933- Regulations. 1939 is amended by omitting paragraph (d) and inserting in its stead the following paragraphs:—
 - "(d) the prevention of the introduction of disease into, or the spread of disease in, the Territory;
 - " (da) the regulation and control of the use of semen in the artificial insemination of stock;".
