STOCK DISEASES ORDINANCE 1958.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1958*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1939*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1958*.

2. Section twelve of the *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1939* is amended by omitting paragraph (d) and inserting in its stead the following paragraphs:— Regulations.

“(d) the prevention of the introduction of disease into, or the spread of disease in, the Territory;

“(da) the regulation and control of the use of semen in the artificial insemination of stock;”.
