BUILDING AND SERVICES ORDINANCE 1976

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Building and Services Ordinance 1976*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2) The *Building and Services Ordinance 1924-1968*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Building and Services Ordinance 1924-1976*.

2. Section 4 of the *Building and Services Ordinance 1924-1968* is Regulations amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (e) the words "One hundred dollars" and substituting the symbol and figures "\$500"; and
- (b) by omitting from that paragraph the words "Ten dollars" and substituting the symbol and figures "\$50".
