MOTOR TRAFFIC ORDINANCE (No. 3) 1976

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Traffic Short title and citation. Ordinance (No. 3) 1976.*
- (2) The Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936-1974,† as amended by the Motor Traffic Ordinance 1976; and the Motor Traffic Ordinance (No. 2) 1976,§ is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3) Section 1 of the Motor Traffic Ordinance (No. 2) 1976 is amended by omitting sub-section (4).
- (4) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936-1976.
 - 2. Section 105 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

Duration of

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (3) the words "as the period for which the registration" and substituting the words "as the number of months for which the registration";
- (b) by inserting after sub-section (3) the following sub-
 - "(3A) In calculating the fee payable under sub-section (3), part of a month shall be treated as a month."; and
- (c) by omitting from sub-regulation (4) the words "the last preceding sub-section" and substituting the words "subsection (3)".
