MOTOR TRAFFIC ORDINANCE (No. 3) 1976

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Motor Traffic Ordinance (No. 3) 1976*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2) The *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936-1974*,[†] as amended by the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1976*[‡] and the *Motor Traffic Ordinance (No. 2) 1976*,[§] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) Section 1 of the *Motor Traffic Ordinance (No. 2) 1976* is amended by omitting sub-section (4).

(4) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936-1976*.

2. Section 105 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (3) the words “as the period for which the registration” and substituting the words “as the number of months for which the registration”;
 - (b) by inserting after sub-section (3) the following sub-section:—
“(3A) In calculating the fee payable under sub-section (3), part of a month shall be treated as a month.”; and
 - (c) by omitting from sub-regulation (4) the words “the last preceding sub-section” and substituting the words “sub-section (3)”.
- Duration of registrations and licences.
