POISONS AND DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE 1976

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Poisons and Dangerous
Drugs Ordinance 1976*.^{*} Short title
and citation.

(2) The *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance 1933-1967*,[†] as
amended by the *Ordinances Revision (Health Commission) Ordinance*
1975,[‡] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) Schedule 2 to the *Ordinances Revision (Health Commission)*
Ordinance 1975 is amended—

(a) by omitting from Column 1 the words and figures "*Poisons
and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance 1933-1967*"; and

(b) by omitting from Column 2 the words and figures "*Poisons
and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance 1933-1975*".

(4) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may
be cited as the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance 1933-1976*.

2. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.

Repeal.

3. Section 26 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by omitting from paragraph (1)(a) all words after the
words "proportion of" and substituting the figures and
words "60 grams of soot or 30 grams of indigo, at the
least, to 1 kilogram of arsenic; and"; and

strychnine.

- (b) by omitting from paragraph (1)(b) all words after “proportion of” and substituting the figures and words “45 grams of Armenian bole or colouring matter to 1 kilogram of strychnine”.
