MEAT ORDINANCE 1976

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Meat Ordinance 1976.* Short title and citation.
- (2) The Meat Ordinance 1931-1968,† as amended by the Ordinances Revision (Health Commission) Ordinance 1975,‡ is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3) Schedule 2 to the Ordinances Revision (Health Commission) Ordinance 1975 is amended-
 - (a) by omitting from Column 1 the words and figures "Meat Ordinance 1931-1968"; and
 - (b) by omitting from Column 2 the words and figures "Meat Ordinance 1931-1975".
- (4) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Meat Ordinance 1931-1976.
- 2. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the Establishwords "ten miles" and substituting the figures and word ment of "16 kilometres".
