AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Meat Ordinance 1931*, as amended by the *Ordinances Revision (Health Commission) Ordinance 1975*.

MEAT ORDINANCE 1976

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Meat Ordinance 1976*.^{*} Short title
and citation.

(2) The *Meat Ordinance 1931-1968*,[†] as amended by the *Ordinances Revision (Health Commission) Ordinance 1975*,[‡] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) Schedule 2 to the *Ordinances Revision (Health Commission) Ordinance 1975* is amended—

(a) by omitting from Column 1 the words and figures "*Meat Ordinance 1931-1968*"; and

(b) by omitting from Column 2 the words and figures "*Meat Ordinance 1931-1975*".

(4) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Meat Ordinance 1931-1976*.

2. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words "ten miles" and substituting the figures and word "16 kilometres". Establishment of
