STOCK DISEASES ORDINANCE 1976

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1976*.^{*} Short title
and citation.

(2) The *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1966*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1976*.

2. Section 11 of the *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1966* is amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the word "half-a-mile" and substituting the figure and word "1 kilometre". Offences.
