STOCK DISEASES ORDINANCE 1976

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Stock Diseases Short title and citation.
- (2) The Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1966,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1976.
- 2. Section 11 of the Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1966 is Offences. amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the word "half-a-mile" and substituting the figure and word "1 kilometre".
