MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1976

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Medical Practitioners Registration (Amendment) Ordinance 1976*.^{*} Short title.

2. Section 29 of the *Medical Practitioners Registration Ordinance 1930*[†] is amended by inserting in sub-section (1), after the word "Chairman", the words "or, if for any reason the Chairman is unable to act, the Deputy Chairman". Provisional permits.
