ANNUAL HOLIDAYS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1976

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Annual Holidays (Amendment) Ordinance 1976*.^{*} Short title.

2. Section 1 of the *Annual Holidays Ordinances 1973*[†] is repealed and the following section substituted:—

“1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Annual Holidays Ordinance 1973*.”. Short title.

3. Section 4 of the *Annual Holidays Ordinances 1973* is amended by omitting sub-section (3) and substituting the following sub-section:— Annual holidays.

“(3) Without prejudice to any rights a person may have under an award or agreement, a person is not entitled under this Ordinance to an annual holiday at the end of a year of employment if, during the year—

- (a) the average number of hours worked by that person in a week did not exceed 24; or
- (b) the person received, under an award or agreement, a payment or payments that was or were in substitution for an annual holiday for that year.”.
