ANNUAL HOLIDAYS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1976

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Annual Holidays (Amend-Short title, ment) Ordinance 1976.*
- 2. Section 1 of the Annual Holidays Ordinances 1973† is repealed and the following section substituted:—
- "1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Annual Holidays Ordin- Short title, ance 1973.".
- 3. Section 4 of the Annual Holidays Ordinances 1973 is amended Annual by omitting sub-section (3) and substituting the following sub-holidays.
- "(3) Without prejudice to any rights a person may have under an award or agreement, a person is not entitled under this Ordinance to an annual holiday at the end of a year of employment if, during the year—
 - (a) the average number of hours worked by that person in a week did not exceed 24; or
 - (b) the person received, under an award or agreement, a payment or payments that was or were in substitution for an annual holiday for that year.".
