LIQUOR ORDINANCE 1976

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Ordinance Short title and citation.
- (2) The Liquor Ordinance (No. 3) 1975,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Liquor Ordinance 1975-1976.
- 2. Section 51 of the Liquor Ordinance (No. 3) 1975 is amended Cancellation by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:— Of licences.
- "(5) The Board shall not make an order under this Division except upon an application made by the Registrar under section 48 or 49.".
