To amend the *Liquor Ordinance (No. 3) 1975*.

LIQUOR ORDINANCE 1976

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Liquor Ordinance* 1976.* Short title
and citation.

(2) The *Liquor Ordinance (No. 3) 1975*,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Liquor Ordinance 1975-1976*.

2. Section 51 of the *Liquor Ordinance (No. 3) 1975* is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:— Cancellation
of licences.

“(5) The Board shall not make an order under this Division except upon an application made by the Registrar under section 48 or 49.”.
