LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1978

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Amend-Short title ment) Ordinance 1978.*
- 2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Legal Principal Practitioners Ordinance 1970.† Ordinance
- 3. Section 6L of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting Expiration "I March 1978" and substituting "the date fixed under sub-section of Part 2 (3) of the Legal Aid Ordinance 1977".
- 4. Section 5 of the Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Ordinance Repeal (No. 3) 1977 is repealed.
- 5. On and after the date fixed under sub-section 2 (3) of the Legal Part 1D to be Aid Ordinance 1977, the Interpretation Ordinance 1967 shall have deemed effect in relation to the provisions of the Principal Ordinance that ceased date of to have effect on that date as if those provisions had been repealed on expiry that date by an Ordinance.
