LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1978

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Ordinance 1978*.^{*} Short title

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1970*.[†] Principal Ordinance

3. Section 6L of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting "1 March 1978" and substituting "the date fixed under sub-section 2 (3) of the *Legal Aid Ordinance 1977*". Expiration of Part

4. Section 5 of the *Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 3) 1977* is repealed. Repeal

5. On and after the date fixed under sub-section 2 (3) of the *Legal Aid Ordinance 1977*, the *Interpretation Ordinance 1967* shall have effect in relation to the provisions of the Principal Ordinance that ceased to have effect on that date as if those provisions had been repealed on that date by an Ordinance. Part 1D to be deemed repealed on date of expiry
