# **Workers Compensation (Default Insurance Fund) Amendment Act 2010**

A2010-12

An Act to amend the Workers Compensation Act 1951

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

### 1 Name of Act

This Act is the Workers Compensation (Default Insurance Fund) Amendment Act 2010.

#### 2 Commencement

- (1) The following sections commence on the day after this Act's notification day:
  - (a) section 3;
  - (b) section 7;
  - (c) section 8;
  - (d) section 9;
  - (e) section 11;
  - (f) section 13.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

- (2) The remaining provisions commence on a day fixed by the Minister by written notice.
  - Note 1 A single day or time may be fixed, or different days or times may be fixed, for the commencement of different provisions (see Legislation Act, s 77 (1)).
  - Note 2 If a provision has not commenced within 6 months beginning on the notification day, it automatically commences on the first day after that period (see Legislation Act, s 79).

#### 3 Legislation amended

This Act amends the Workers Compensation Act 1951.

## 4 Functions of committee Schedule 3, section 3.3 (1)

- (1) The committee has the following functions:
  - (a) to keep informed of the operations of the DI fund to provide the advice mentioned in paragraph (b);
  - (b) if the Minister or the DI fund manager asks for advice in relation to the DI fund—to provide the advice requested.

  - (a) 1 member that the Minister is satisfied represents the interests of employers;
  - (b) 1 member that the Minister is satisfied represents the interests of workers;
  - (c) 1 member that the Minister is satisfied represents the interests of insurers.
