- (2) A law mentioned in section 4, 4A or 4B has effect only if—
- (a) it is passed by—
 - (i) the Legislative Assembly; and
 - (ii) a majority of electors at a referendum held in accordance with the Referendum (Machinery Provisions) Act 1994; or
 - (b) it is passed by at least a $\frac{2}{3}$ majority of the members of the Legislative Assembly.
