An Act to amend the *Magistrates Court Act 1930*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

2 **1 Name of Act**

3 This Act is the *Magistrates Court Amendment Act 2001*.

4 **2 Commencement**

5 This Act commences on the day it is notified in the Gazette or  
6 immediately after the commencement of the *Fair Trading*  
7 *Legislation Amendment Act 2001*, whichever is later.

8 **3 Act amended**

9 This Act amends the *Magistrates Court Act 1930*.
