1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Agents Amendment Act 2001*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day it is notified in the Gazette.

(1) A claim for compensation must—

(a) be in writing; and

(b) be given to the board within the appropriate period; and

(c) state the full name and home address of the claimant; and

(d) contain full particulars of the claim; and

(e) be accompanied by a statutory declaration to the effect that the
particulars contained in the claim are true.(2) The board must reject a claim that does not, at the time it is given,
comply with subsection (1).(3) The *appropriate period* is the earlier of—

- 1 (a) 1 year after the day the claimant becomes aware of the failure
2 to account to which the claim relates; or
3 (b) 2 years after the day the failure to account happens; and
4 (4) However, if before the end of the period within which a claim for
5 compensation would, apart from this subsection, be required to be
6 given, a notice about the making of the claim is published under
7 section 71Z, the *appropriate period* is the period mentioned in the
8 notice.
