## **Financial Management Amendment Bill 2000**

### A BILL

### An Act to amend the Financial Management Act 1996

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Financial Management Amendment Act 2000.

5 2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day it is notified in the Gazette.

3 Act amended

This Act amends the Financial Management Act 1996.

After section 66 the following section is inserted:

# "66A Territory contracts not to prevent disclosure etc to the Legislative Assembly

- "(1) A provision of a contract made by the Territory or a Territory authority is void if it prevents or impedes, or purports to prevent or impede—
  - (a) disclosure to the Legislative Assembly of the terms, or any of the terms, of the contract; or
  - (b) production to the Legislative Assembly of a document containing the contract or any part of the contract.
  - "(2) The validity of a contract is not otherwise affected by this section.
  - "(3) A provision of a contract is not void under subsection (1) if, before or after the contract is made, the Minister signs a certificate to the effect that, in the circumstances of the particular contract or proposed contract, the provision is reasonable and necessary.
  - "(4) If the Minister signs a certificate, the Minister must cause a copy of the relevant contract or proposed contract, and a copy of the certificate, to be given to the auditor-general for examination.
- "(5) The auditor-general must, for each period specified in subsection (6), give a written report to the Legislative Assembly on the contracts and proposed contracts that the auditor-general has examined during the period.
  - "(6) For subsection (5), the periods are each period of 6 months beginning on 1 January or 1 July in a year.
- 25 "(7) This section does not detract from the privileges and powers of the Legislative Assembly.
  - "(8) In this section—

contract includes obligation.

Legislative Assembly includes, except in subsection (5), a committee of the Legislative Assembly.

provision, in a contract, includes a term or condition of the contract.".

#### 5 Transitional

- (1) For the period beginning on the date of commencement of this section and ending on 30 June or 31 December (whichever first occurs after that date), section 66A of the *Financial Management Act 1996*, as inserted by section 4 of this Act, has effect as though subsection (6) were omitted and the following subsection substituted:
- "(6) For subsection (5), the first period is the period beginning on the date of commencement of this section and ending on 30 June or 31 December (whichever first occurs after that date).".
- 10 (2) This section lapses on 1 January or 1 July (whichever first occurs) after the date of commencement of this section.
