An Act to amend the Land (Planning and Environment) Regulations 1992

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Land (Planning and Environment) Legislation Amendment Act 2000.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day it is notified in the Gazette.

3 Legislation amended

This Act amends the Land (Planning and Environment) Regulations

4 Exclusion of appeals by objectors—Act, s 276

Regulation 24 is amended by adding at the end the following subregulations:

- "(4) Despite the amendment of Schedule 7 by the Land (Planning and Environment) Legislation Amendment Act 2000, section 276 of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991 does not apply to a decision of the relevant authority about a development consisting of the erection, alteration or demolition of a single dwelling on a parcel of land if the development would not result in there being more than 1 dwelling on the land and application for approval to undertake the development had been made before the amendment took effect.
 - "(5) Subregulation (4) and this subregulation cease to have effect on 31 December 2000.".

5 Schedule 7

Schedule 7 is amended by omitting item 5.
