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Electoral (Amendment) Bill 1999

A BILL

FOR

An Act to amend the *Electoral Act 1992* and for related purposes

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

- 1. Short title
 - This Act may be cited as the Electoral (Amendment) Act 1999.
- 2. Commencement
 - (1) Sections 1, 2 and 3 commence on the day this Act is notified in the Gazette.
 - (2) The remaining provisions commence on a day, or respective days, fixed by the Minister by notice in the Gazette.
- 10 (3) If a provision mentioned in subsection (2) has not commenced within 6 months beginning on the day this Act is notified in the Gazette, it commences, by force of this subsection, on the first day after that period.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Electoral Act 1992.1

4. Heading to Division 4 of Part 14

The heading to Division 4 of Part 14 of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end "made during a reporting period".

5. Parties to advise donors of obligation to lodge return

Section 221B of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) "221A" and substituting "231D"

6. Relocation and renumbering—sections 221A and 221B

Sections 221A and 221B of the Principal Act, as amended by this Act, are relocated so that they appear immediately after section 231C and are renumbered 231D and 231E respectively.

7. Substitution

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Section 228 of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section substituted:

"228. Definition

In this Division-

'defined details', in relation to a sum that has been received, paid or owed, means—

- (a) for a sum received from, paid to or owed to, an unincorporated association, other than a registered industrial organisation—
 - (i) the association name; and
 - (ii) the name and address of each member of the association executive committee (however described);
- (b) for a sum received from, paid to or owed to, a trust fund or a foundation—
 - (i) the name and address of each trustee of the fund or foundation; and
 - (ii) the name, title or description of the trust fund or foundation;
- (c) in any other case—the name and address of the person or organisation that paid, received or was or is owed the sum; and
- (d) in any case—other details prescribed under the regulations.".

8. Annual returns by parties and MLAs

Section 230 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraphs (2) (a), (b) and (c) "particulars" and substituting "details".

9. Periods of less than financial year

Section 231 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "particulars" and substituting "details".

10. Repeal

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Section 231A of the Principal Act is repealed.

11. Annual returns by associated entities

Section 231B of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraphs (2) (a), (b) and (c) "particulars" and substituting "details".

12. Repeal

Section 231C of the Principal Act is repealed.

13. Details of amounts received

Section 232 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (1) "\$1,500" and substituting "\$500";
- (b) by omitting from subsection (1) "particulars" and substituting "details"; and
- (c) by omitting subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:
 - "(2) In calculating the sum, an amount that was received from a person or organisation in the course of a fund-raising event need not be counted unless the total amount received from the person or organisation in the course of that event was \$100 or more."

25 14. Details of amounts paid

Section 233 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (1) "\$1,500" and substituting "\$500";
- (b) by omitting from subsection (1) "particulars" and substituting "details"; and
- (c) by omitting from paragraph (2) (a) "\$500" and substituting "\$100".

15. Details of outstanding amounts

Section 234 of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting from subsection (1) "\$1,500" and substituting "\$500";

- (b) by omitting from subsection (1) "particulars" and substituting "details";
- (c) by omitting from subsection (2) "\$1,500" and substituting "\$500"; and
- 5 (d) by omitting from subsection (2) "particulars" and substituting "details".

16. Regulations

Section 234A of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (3).

10 17. Partial renumbering of Electoral Act

In the next republication of the *Electoral Act 1992*, the provisions of that Act beginning at section 198 must be renumbered as permitted under section 13 of the *Legislation (Republication) Act 1996*.
