An Act to amend the Motor Traffic Act 1936

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

- 1. Short title
 - This Act may be cited as the Motor Traffic (Amendment) Act (No.2) 1998
- 2. Commencement
- This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the Gazette
 - 3. Principal Act

In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Motor Traffic Act 1936.1

- 4. Driving licence to be produced on demand
- Section 172 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) all the words after "reasonable excuse"
