An Act to amend the Discrimination Act 1991

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

2		This Act is the Discrimination Amendment Act 2010.

16		goods or services if the person reasonably believes that—
17		(a) the other person is a student at a school; and
