

STREET NOMENCLATURE

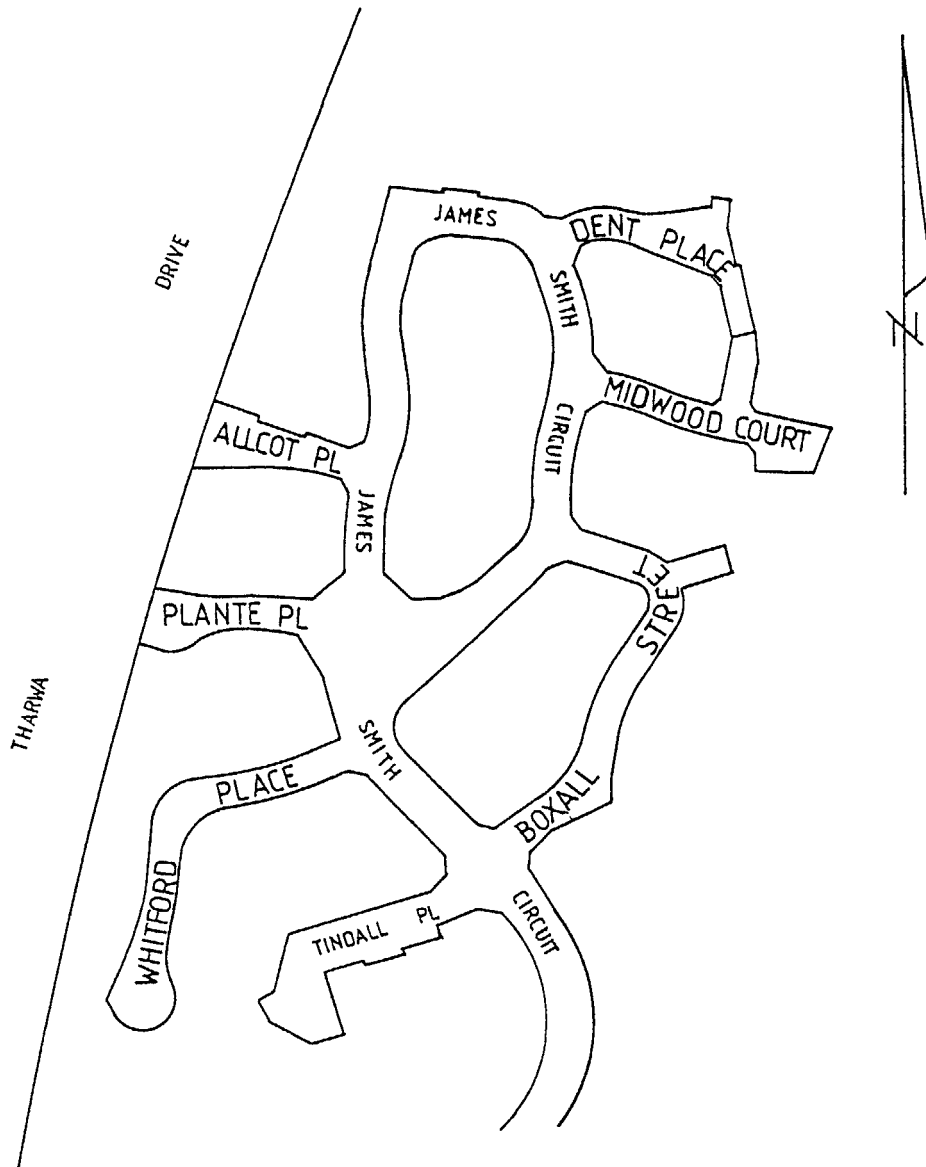

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Allcot Place	John Allcot (1888-1973)	Artist, notable for his paintings of ships
Boxall Street	Arthur d'Auvergne Boxall (1895-1944)	Teacher of art and notable landscape artist
Dent Place	Aileen Dent (1890-1979)	Portrait painter
Midwood Court	Tom Midwood (1855-1912)	Prominent cartoonist in Hobart during the late 1800s
Plante Place	Ada Plante (1875-1950)	Artist who is remembered for her post impressionist landscapes
Whitford Place	Dora Whitford (1898-1969)	Painter, etcher, commercial artist and stained-glass designer


