Waste Minimisation 2001, section 45 - Determination of fees

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Waste Minimisation (Landfill Fees) Determination 2010 (No 1).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 July 2010.

3 Revocation of previous determinations

The following instruments are revoked:

- (a) the Waste Minimisation (Landfill Fees) Determination 2009 (No 1) DI2009—85:
- (b) the Waste Minimisation (West Belconnen Borrow Pit Remediation Fees) Determination 2009 (No 1) DI2009—207.

4 Determination of fees

The fee payable in respect of each matter listed in an item in the schedule, column 2 is the amount listed for that item in column 4.

5 Payment of fee

A fee listed in the schedule is payable to the Territory by the person requesting the goods or service listed.

6 Fee Waivers

The Minister may waive a fee listed in the schedule if it is in the public interest to do so.

Example

The Minister decides to waive landfill fees for waste material generated as a result of a natural disaster.

7 Goods and services tax

Where applicable, GST inclusive fees are marked with a double asterisk (**).

8 Dictionary

In this instrument:

contaminated remediation material means soil that has been approved for acceptance by the Environment Protection Authority and that is contaminated with small amounts of bonded asbestos sheeting, or soil contaminated with small amounts of other contaminants.

beneficial re-use remediation material means material such as clay, gravel, sand, soil and rock that that has been approved for acceptance by the Environment Protection Authority and that has been extracted from areas that are contaminated or have been previously contaminated.

virgin excavation natural material means excavated material such as clay, gravel, sand, soil and rock that has been approved for acceptance by the Environment Protection Authority, that is not mixed with any other waste and:

- (a) has been excavated from an area:
 - (i) that is not contaminated with manufactured chemicals, as a result of industrial, commercial, mining or agricultural activities; or
 - (ii) that does not contain sulphidic ores or soils; or
- (b) consists of excavated natural material.
