

Whitlam	The Hon. (Edward) Gough Whitlam AC, QC (1916-2014)	21 st Prime Minister of Australia. The Hon. Gough Whitlam AC, QC was Prime Minister of Australia from 5 December 1972 to 11 November 1975; the first Labor Prime Minister since 1949. Gough Whitlam was MHR for the Federal
		Seat of Werriwa (NSW) from 1952-78. He was elected Leader of the federal parliamentary Australian Labor Party (ALP) in February 1967 and was Leader of the Opposition from 1967-72.
		In office Whitlam held the portfolio of Foreign Affairs until 6 November 1973.
		Whitlam stood down as Leader of the ALP after the 1977 Federal election and resigned his seat in parliament on 31 July 1978.
		He served as the Australian Ambassador to UNESCO from 1983-86 and Chair of the Council of the National Gallery of Australia from 1987-90.
