EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Outline

This Bill removes the provision for Defined Land in the *Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991*.

Clauses

Clauses 1, 2 and 3 are formal requirements which set out the name of the Act, commencement provisions and the name of the Act amended.

Clauses 4 and 5 remove the power to identify land as Defined Land in the Territory Plan

Clause 6 is a consequential amendment to Clause 7

Clause 7 omits part 2, division 3, subdivision D of the Act relating to the process for undertaking Territory Plan variations for Defined Land.

Clauses 8, 9 and 10 are consequential amendments to Clause 7

Clause 11 inserts a transitional provision that allows the provisions of part 2, division 3, subdivision D to continue for Defined Land that at the time of the commencement of the Act was privately leased or for which the Government had entered an agreement to grant a lease.
