Motor Traffic (Amendment) Bill 1999

OUTLINE

The purpose of this Bill is to remove an anomaly from the law governing seat belts to ensure that they are worn when they are fitted in a motor vehicle and to restrict the number of people in a motor vehicle to the number of seat belts in the motor vehicle.

CLAUSE NOTES

Clauses 1, 2 and 3 are formal requirements. They refer to the short title of the Bill; specify that the Bill will commence upon being notified in the Gazette; and identify the title of the Act being amended.

Clause 4 inserts new section "164BA" to the Principle Act. This section states that a person shall not drive a motor vehicle on a public street if the vehicle has more passengers than there are seating positions.

Clause 5 amends section "164C" paragraph (b) of the Principle Act to ensure that an occupant of a motor vehicle uses a seat belt if there is one available.
