## AN ORDINANCE

## To amend the Advisory Council Ordinance 1930-1931.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1931, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Advisory Council Short title and Ordinance 1932.
- (2.) The Advisory Council Ordinance 1930-1931 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Advisory Council Ordinance 1930-1932.
- 2. Section three of the Principal Ordinance is amended by pefinitions. omitting the definition of "Civic Administrator".
- 3. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by constitution of omitting the words—

  Council.

"The Secretary, Department of Home Affairs;

The Director-General of Health;

The Secretary, Department of Works and Railways;

The Civic Administrator; and",

and inserting in their stead the words—

"The Director-General of Health;

The Assistant Secretary (Works and Services), Department of the Interior;

The Assistant Secretary (Civic Representative), Department of the Interior:

The Assistant Secretary (Property and Surveys), Department of the Interior; and".

4. Section seven of the Principal Ordinance is repealed. 1451.—PRICE 3D.

Appointment of Civic Administrator.

Chairman of Advisory Council.

- **5**. Section eight of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—
- "8.—(1.) The Minister may appoint one of the members of the Council to be the Chairman and, on the happening of any vacancy in the office of Chairman, the Minister shall appoint a person to fill that office.
- "(2.) Until an appointment is made by the Minister under the last preceding sub-section, the Director-General of Health shall be Chairman of the Council.
- "(3.) The Chairman shall preside at all meetings of the Council at which he is present and, in the event of an equality of voting, shall have a vote but not otherwise."

Deputy Chairman. 6. Section nine of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words "have a deliberative vote, and, in the event of an equality of voting, a second or easting vote" and inserting in their stead the words ", in the event of an equality of voting, have a vote, but not otherwise".

Meetings of the Council.

- **7.** Section ten of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (1.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-section:—
- "(1.) The first meeting of the Council shall be convened by the Minister by notice in writing to each member of the Council within fourteen days after the commencement of this sub-section.".
