AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Mortgagors' Interest Reduction Ordinance 1931.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia with the admirant of the Commonwealth of Australia with the Commonwealth of Commonwea Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Mortgagors' Short title and Interest Reduction Ordinance 1935.

(2.) The Mortgagors' Interest Reduction Ordinance 1931 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Mortgagors' Interest Reduction Ordinance 1931-1935

2. Section three of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Definition of adding at the end of the definition of "Mortgage" the words "and "Mortgage" also includes any deed, instrument or agreement whereby a guarantee or personal security is given for the payment of moneys granted by a bank or corporation on overdraft".

3. Section five of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

Application for reduction of

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (1.) the words "com-interest. mencement of this Ordinance" and inserting in their stead the words "twenty-first day of November, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-five"; and
- (b) by inserting, after sub-section (2.) the following subsection :-
 - "(2A.) Every application under this section shall, if the mortgagor or mortgagee so desires, be heard in camera.".
- 4. Section six of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Effect of omitting from sub-section (2.) the words "commencement of this Ordinance" and inserting in their stead the words "twenty-first day of November, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-five".
