## AN ORDINANCE

## To amend the Hawkers Ordinance 1926-1934.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Hawkers* short title Ordinance 1935.
- (2.) The Hawkers Ordinance 1926-1934 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Hawkers Ordinance* 1926-1935.
- 2. Section nine of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Recognizance. omitting the words "two Justices" and inserting in their stead the words "a Justice of the Peace".
- 3. Form C of the First Schedule to the Principal Ordinance First Schedule. is amended—
  - (a) by omitting the word "us" (wherever occurring) and inserting in its stead the word "me"; and
  - (b) by omitting the words "Esquires, Justices of the Peace" and inserting in their stead the words "Esquire, Justice of the Peace".
