## AN ORDINANCE

### To amend the Liquor Ordinance 1929-1942.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Ordinance Short title 1943.\*
- (2.) The Liquor Ordinance 1929-1942 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Liquor Ordinance 1929-1943.
- 2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation commencement on the date of commencement of the Liquor Ordinance 1942 and this Ordinance. shall continue in operation until the date fixed by the Minister in pursuance of section two of that Ordinance, and no longer.

3. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended—

Amendment of

- (a) by inserting in Form 1, after the word "morning", the words "to two o'clock in the afternoon and from four o'clock in the afternoon";
- (b) by inserting in Form 3, after the word "forenoon", the words "until two o'clock in the afternoon and from four o'clock in the afternoon"; and
- (c) by inserting in Form 4, after the word "morning", the words "to two o'clock in the afternoon and from four o'clock in the afternoon".
