

NURSES REGISTRATION

No. 35 of 1970

An Ordinance to amend the *Nurses Registration Ordinance* 1933-1967.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Nurses Registration Ordinance* 1970.* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Nurses Registration Ordinance* 1933-1967,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Nurses Registration Ordinance* 1933-1970.

2. Section 11 of the *Nurses Registration Ordinance* 1933-1967 is amended— Power to send for witnesses and documents.

(a) by omitting sub-section (3.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-section:—

“ (3.) A person who attends for the purpose of giving evidence before the Board is entitled to receive such fees and travelling expenses in accordance with the scale in the Second Schedule to the Public Works Committee Regulations as in force from time to time under the *Public Works Committee Act* 1969 as the Chairman determines.”; and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (4.) the word “allowances” and inserting in its stead the word “expenses”.

3. Section 44 of the *Nurses Registration Ordinance* 1933-1967 is amended— Power of Minister to determine charges.

(a) by omitting sub-section (4.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-section:—

“ (4.) A person (not being a party) who attends before the Minister for the purpose of giving evidence is entitled to receive such fees and travelling expenses in accordance with the scale in the Second Schedule to the Public Works Committee Regulations as in force from time to time under the *Public Works Committee Act* 1969 as the Minister determines.”; and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (5.) the word “allowances” and inserting in its stead the word “expenses”.
