To amend the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933-1970*, as amended by the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1971*.

NURSES REGISTRATION ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1971

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Nurses Registration Ordinance (No. 2) 1971*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933-1970*,[†] as amended by the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1971*,[‡] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) Section 1 of the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1971* is amended by omitting sub-section (3.).

(4.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933-1971*.

2. Section 22 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by inserting in paragraph (a) of sub-section (1.), after the words "three years", the words "or, if the person is a person who was admitted to a two-year course of training in the theory and practice of nursing by reason of holding the higher educational qualifications prescribed for the purposes of this paragraph, for not less than two years,"; and

- (b) by inserting in paragraph (b) of that sub-section after the word “undergoes” the words “, during the attendance referred to in the last preceding paragraph,”.

3. Section 22B of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting paragraph (a) of sub-section (1.) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:—

“(a) has attained the age of nineteen years;”.
