**To amend the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933–1971*,
as amended by the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1973*.**

NURSES REGISTRATION ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1973

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Nurses Registration Ordinance (No. 2) 1973*.^{*} Short title
and citation.

(2) The *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933–1971*,[†] as amended by the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1973*,[‡] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) Section 1 of the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1973* is amended by omitting sub-section (3).

(4) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933–1973*.

2. Section 28L of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section substituted:—

“28L. (1) A person other than—

(a) a person enrolled as a nursing aid; or

(b) a person who is undergoing a course of training approved by the Board at a hospital approved by the Board,

shall not be employed as a nursing aid.

“ (2) A person shall not be employed as a nursing aid except in a hospital and under the supervision of a registered nurse.

“ (3) Nothing in this section applies to a person who occupies an office under the *Public Service Act 1922–1973* of Nursing Aide.”.

3. Section 41 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following word and paragraph:—

“; or (f) the giving or performance, under the supervision of a registered nurse and in the performance of her official duties, of any nursing service by a person who occupies an office under the *Public Service Act* 1922-1973 of *Nursing Aide*.”.
