NURSES REGISTRATION ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1973

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Nurses Registration Short title Ordinance (No. 2) 1973.*
- (2) The Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933-1971,† as amended by the Nurses Registration Ordinance 1973,‡ is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3) Section 1 of the Nurses Registration Ordinance 1973 is amended by omitting sub-section (3).
- (4) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Nurses Registration Ordinance* 1933-1973.
- 2. Section 28L of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section substituted:—
 - "28L. (1) A person other than-
 - (a) a person enrolled as a nursing aid; or

(b) a person who is undergoing a course of training approved by the Board at a hospital approved by the Board,

- shall not be employed as a nursing aid.
- "(2) A person shall not be employed as a nursing aid except in a hospital and under the supervision of a registered nurse.
- "(3) Nothing in this section applies to a person who occupies an office under the *Public Service Act* 1922-1973 of Nursing Aide.".

Application of Part IV.

- 3. Section 41 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following word and paragraph:—
 - "; or (f) the giving or performance, under the supervision of a registered nurse and in the performance of her official duties, of any nursing service by a person who occupies an office under the *Public Service Act* 1922-1973 of Nursing Aide.".
