## AN ORDINANCE

### To amend the *Festival Australia Incorporation Ordinance* 1973-1975.

### FESTIVAL AUSTRALIA INCORPORATION ORDINANCE 1976

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Festival Australia Incorporation Ordinance* 1976.\* Short title and citation.

(2) The *Festival Australia Incorporation Ordinance* 1973-1975,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Festival Australia Incorporation Ordinance* 1973-1976.

2. (1) The Schedule to the *Festival Australia Incorporation Ordinance* 1973-1975 is amended by omitting paragraph 9 (1)(d) and substituting the following paragraphs:— Schedule.

- “(d) an officer or employee of the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet appointed as occasion requires by the Secretary of that Department;
- (e) an officer or employee of the Department of the Treasury appointed as occasion requires by the Secretary of that Department;
- (f) 6 persons elected in accordance with the rules who shall hold office, subject to this Constitution, for three years and be eligible for re-election at the end of each term.”.

(2) The Schedule to the *Festival Australia Incorporation Ordinance* 1973-1975 is amended by omitting sub-clauses 9 (4) and 9 (5) and substituting the following sub-clauses:—

“(4) In addition to the persons referred to in paragraphs 9 (1)(a), 9 (1)(b) and 9 (1)(c) and the person referred to in sub-clause 9 (2), the members of the Board for the period that commenced on 1 July 1975 shall be:—

Margot Macdonald Anthony  
Arthur John Birch  
Peter Rutherford Carrodus  
Louis William Bircham Engledow  
Henry Dermot O'Clery  
Joy Warren.

“(5) The persons who hold office as members of the Board by virtue of sub-clause (4) shall hold office until—

(a) elections for members of the Board are held pursuant to the Rules; or

(b) 30 June 1978,  
whichever first occurs.”.

Application.      3. The amendments made by sub-section 2 (2) shall be deemed to have had effect on and from 1 July 1975.
