CIGARETTE CONTAINERS (LABELLING) ORDINANCE 1976

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Cigarette Containers Short title (Labelling) Ordinance 1976.* and citation.
- (2) The Cigarette Containers (Labelling) Ordinance 1972,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Cigarette Containers (Labelling) Ordinance 1972-1976.
- 2. Section 5 of the Cigarette Containers (Labelling) Ordinance Health 1972 is amended by omitting from paragraph (2) (b) the words "one-sixteenth of an inch" and substituting the figures and word cigarette " 1.5 millimetres ".
