CIGARETTE CONTAINERS (LABELLING) ORDINANCE 1976

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Cigarette Containers (Labelling) Ordinance 1976*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2) The *Cigarette Containers (Labelling) Ordinance 1972*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Cigarette Containers (Labelling) Ordinance 1972-1976*.

2. Section 5 of the *Cigarette Containers (Labelling) Ordinance 1972* is amended by omitting from paragraph (2) (b) the words "one-sixteenth of an inch" and substituting the figures and word "1.5 millimetres". Health warning to appear on cigarette containers.
